

# MCCA 2006 Annual Program Report

**Vision Quest-** 9 trips allowed 95 youth to participate in this program in 2006.

**Philadelphia, Pennsylvania (2 trip) (20 boys)** - Youth where housed in Ambler Pennsylvania just 20 miles from Philadelphia. Youth toured St. Joseph, Villanova, Temple, Penn, Lincoln and Cheney Universities. Also they toured Philadelphia, Reading, Allentown and New York City culminating with a day at Downey Park Wild Water Kingdom theme park.

**Madison, Wisconsin (3 Trips) (35 youth)** - Youth visited the state capital, toured Madison University and attended a Badger game during there 3 day stay in downtown Madison.

**Concordia University (4 trips) (40 youth)** - Youth lived on campus for 5 days while attending sports camps and college seminars focused on leadership, self-discipline, high education and individual goal setting.

**Gifts of Love-350 youth** participated in the program. **December 20<sup>th</sup> Christmas Party (350 youth)**- This year we partnered with Cardinal Stritch University to host our first annual Gifts of Love Christmas party. The event highlighted the 2006 program year and presented gifts to children who participated in MCCA programs this year.

**The Minority Christian Coaches Association (MCCA) was able to offer youth in Milwaukee this year the following programs. The participation of youth, families and volunteers who benefited from these programs is as follows:**

**Team Fitness-13** Program sites hosted about 960 youth in this program in 2006.

**Best Friend Programs (9 sites)** - These sites have around 560 young girls in there program and the team fitness program is offered to these young ladies twice a month starting in November 2006 through May 2007.

**Community Learning Centers (CLC) (4 sites)-** These sites have over 400 young boys and girls who participate in the team fitness programs twice a week for 8 weeks. Sites begin the programs in October and finish in May. Each site participates in three 8-week sessions during the course of the year. Participants in this program are kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

**Weekend Adventurers-** 20 trips hosted 145 boys and girls in this program in 2006.

**Indian Mound Reservation (20 trips) (145 youth)** – Youth had the opportunity to stay in cabins and participate in hiking, fishing, high ropes, rock climbing, team clinics and canoeing. Each weekend youth attended local churches and where hosted by families as well. Ten trips where scheduled in the Fall and ten in the Spring.

**Student Internships-** 3 sites hosted 85 interns in this program in 2006.

**Sports Camps (5 sites) ( 10 interns)-** Throughout the year MCCA partnered with schools and community agencies to provide student interns to help assist with team fitness programs, camps, devotions and sports clinics.

**Team Collection Workers (1 site) (75 interns)-** During the Spring, Summer and Fall months interns where trained to go door-to-door collecting pledges for program support. Youth traveled all over the state working in teams raising support for the intern program and other programs offered by MCCA.

**Sports Academy-** 2 sites hosted 250 youth in this program in 2006.

**35<sup>th</sup> Street School (1 site) (175 youth)** – Interns served at this site and provided sports instructional clinics, youth leadership, tutoring and individual counseling for disadvantaged youth campers.

**New Beginnings Are Possible (1 site) (75)** – Interns served at this site and provided sports instructional clinics, youth leadership, tutoring and individual counseling for disadvantaged youth campers.



**Team Leagues-** 1 league hosted 250 youth in this program in 2006.

**Milwaukee Christian Fellowship Basketball League (MCFBL) (1 league) (250 youth)**

– The MCFBL hosted 18 churches in the coed league from December through April. The league played at North Division High School each Saturday evening from 6:00pm to 9:00pm.

**Urban Missions-** 325 families participated in this program in 2006

**Missions (325 families)-** Churches and community partners throughout the Wisconsin helped the MCCA in this program by participating in the Gifts of Love Pledgathon & gift wrapping project. Each organization helped raise money, gifts and awareness for our programs while interacting and hosting inner-city youth at their facilities.
